Fireworks are going off in France today as the French celebrate Bastille Day! This is when the French commemorate the storming of the Bastille in 1789, to free political prisoners of King Louis XVI, and get ammunition, which set off the French Revolution as people of France sought to overturn the tyrannical rule of the monarchy. (We were camping in Germany across the border with France many years ago, on French Bastille Day, which is also our daughter's birthday. We told her the fireworks were to celebrate her birthday!)

Peter & Kathy Lee are Serve Globally missionaries in Lyon France where Peter serves in ministries to displaced peoples coming to France from different countries.
